**Bric's Pininfarina A solo** Italian line key case for the organised packer, with built-in clothes hangers and padded pockets. £280 (020 7730 1234; [www.brics.it](http://www.brics.it))

**Rimowa Topas Gold •ULTRATRAVEL CHOICE** This 1950s-style case is constructed from gold-anodised aluminium. The Multiwheel model (pictured) has four pairs of swivelling wheels, so it can spin through 360 degrees with ease. £700 (020 7730 1234; [www.rimowa.de](http://www.rimowa.de))

**Brooks Brothers High-Shine Spazzolato** Standing 27in tall on its wheels, this hard case in fine leather has brass fittings and a luxurious, fully lined interior. From £2,199 (020 238 0030; [www.brooksbrothers.com](http://www.brooksbrothers.com))
